## Charlotte secures sustainable employment from work experience opportunity with AECOM

Through the HS2 Women into Construction pilot project, Charlotte has a new career as an Ecological Assistant for HS2 contractor AECOM.

Having no previous experience in ecology, Charlotte undertook a successful four-week work experience placement with AECOM who gave her a six month contract, which has now been extended further.

During her placement she carried out tree surveys, checking for bats and tagging them to follow their movements and discover where their nests were.
